Arusha * Tarangire * Ngorongoro * Serengeti * Lake Manyara

DAY 1 ARUSHA

Meet at arrival point and transfer to your lodge for pre-safari briefing.

DAY 2 ARUSHA-LAKE MANYARA

We transfer into Lake Manyara for morning game drive and lunch, a classic safari picnic, and enjoy our final glimpse of the great wilds of the Northern Tanzania. Lake Manyara offers an insight into the Great Rift Valley system and the adaptation of many herd animals and magnificent birdlife. We continue Esilalei Maasai Village to explore the area and our school project. In the late afternoon, we zig zag our way up the Rift Valley

Escarpment and into the Ngorongoro crater highlands for overnight.

DAY 3 LAKE MANYARA-NGORONGORO

Short drive to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Ngorongoro is collapsed volcano - an incredible natural amphitheatre, 25 km across and teeming with all of the African big game. Early morning descent into the crater for spectacular scenery and game viewing in what has been described as the eighth wonder of the world. Tonight we are staying in Rhino Lodge owned and run by the Maasai here. Located in the Crater forest, it is quite common for zebra, buffalo and even elephant to be grazing right outside the lodge.

DAY 4 NGORONGORO-SERENGETI

We depart after breakfast to the endless plains of the central Serengeti. Upon entering the Serengeti, we are able to game drive migratory or resident wildlife all the way to our camp in the heart of the endless plains, enjoying a picnic lunch enroute

DAY 5 SERENGETI

We enjoy further exploration of the endless plains. The habitats are natural and we can game drive with a picnic lunch to explore further afield. There are resident cats and herd animals for us to observe.

SAFARI

The Swahili word safari means long journey, originally from the Arabic سفرية (safarīyah) meaning a journey. The verb for "to travel" in Swahili is "kusafiri", the noun for the journey is "safari". These words are used for any type of journey, e.g., by bus from Nairobi to Mombasa or by ferry from Dar es Salaam to Unguja. Safari entere d the English language in the late 19th century. In 1836 William Cornwallis

Harris led an expedition purely to observe and record wildlife and landscapes by the expedition's members. Harris established the safari style of journey, starting with a not too strenuous rising at first light, an energetic day walking, an afternoon rest then concluding with a formal dinner and telling stories in the evening over drinks and tobacco.

DAY 6 SERENGETI

We take part in an early morning game drive before returning for lunch and resting. In the afternoon, we set off to see the nocturnal animals beginning their night's work. It is also a perfect location to partake in the breath-taking Serengeti Balloon Safari (optional).

DAY 7 SERENGETI-TARANGIRE

We transfer out of the Serengeti, passing through Oldupai Gorge. We enjoy lunch and a view of the archaeological sites (and visit the museum) where early human tools and fossils have been found. We set off in the direction of Tarangire National Park and arrive to our camp for sunset. This camp provides us with a classic bush experience that ensures intimacy.

DAY 8 TARANGIRE-ARUSHA-BEYOND

Early morning game driving in Tarangire National Park; this park is famed for its massive elephant herds, true sense of wilderness and backdrop of baobabs. This is true Africa and the perfect way to end our adventures. You are then transferred to Arusha and your departure point or lodge (Breakfast, Lunch)
