Arusha * Tarangire * Ngorongoro * Serengeti * Lake Manyara

DAY 1 ARUSHA

Meet at arrival point and transfer to your lodge for pre-safari briefing.

ARUSHA COFFEE LODGE (Dinner)

DAY 2 ARUSHA-TARANGIRE

We transfer into Tarangire for morning game drive and lunch, a classic safari picnic, and enjoy our final glimpse of the great wilds of the Northern Tanzania. Tarangire is famed for its massive elephant herds, a true sense of wilderness and a backdrop of baobabs. Continue to tented camp just outside the park for overnight.

TARANGIRE TREETOPS (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 3 TARANGIRE-LAKE MANYARA-NGORONGORO

After breakfast, transfer to Esilalei Maasai Village to explore the area and our school project. Continue onto Lake Manyara for game driving and lunch, a classic safari picnic. Lake Manyara offers an insight into the Great Rift Valley system and the adaptation of many herd animals and magnificent birdlife. In the late afternoon, we zig zag our way up the Rift Valley Escarpment and onto the crater highlands for overnight.

THE MANOR AT NGORONGORO (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 4 NGORONGORO

Short drive to the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. Ngorongoro is collapsed volcano - an incredible natural amphitheatre, 25 km across and teeming with all of the African big game. Early morning descent into the crater for spectacular scenery and game viewing in what has been described as the eighth wonder of the world. Return to the Cape Dutche style lodge for overnight. It is quite common for buffalo and even elephant to be grazing right outside the lodge.

THE MANOR AT NGORONGORO (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 5 NGORONGORO-SERENGETI

We depart after breakfast to the endless plains of the Serengeti, via exploration of the Ndutu plains area. Upon entering the Serengeti, we are able to game drive all the way to our special camp area. The camp option is recommended to suit the season of travel.

SAFARI

The Swahili word safari means long journey, originally from the Arabic سفريه (safariyah) meaning a journey. The verb for "to travel" in Swahili is "kusafiri", the noun for the journey is "safari". These words are used for any type of journey, e.g., by bus from Nairobi to Mombasa or by ferry from Dar es Salaam to Unguja. Safari entered the English language in the late 19th century. The person generally attributed to having used the word in English is Sir Richard Francis Burton, the famous explorer.

In 1836 William Cornwallis

Harris led an expedition purely to observe and record wildlife and landscapes by the expedition's members. Harris established the safari style of journey, starting with a not too strenuous rising at first light, an energetic day walking, an afternoon rest then concluding with a formal dinner and telling stories in the evening over drinks and tobacco.

DAY 6 SERENGETI

We take part in an early morning game drive before returning for lunch and resting. In the afternoon, we set off to see the nocturnal animals beginning their night's work. It is also a perfect location to partake in the breath-taking Serengeti Balloon Safari (optional).

EHLANE PLAINS CAMP or KASKAZ MARA CAMP, season depending (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 7 SERENGETI

Game driving and exploration in this unique area of the Serengeti—endless plains, riverines and stunning resident wildlife all year round. It is while in the heart of the Serengeti eco-system where you can truly understand why the Serengeti is named after the Maasai word of 'Siringit' which means endless plains.

EHLANE PLAINS CAMP or KASKAZ MARA CAMP, season depending (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 8 SERENGETI-ARUSHA-BEYOND

Early morning game driving to central Serengeti for charter flight back to Arusha and your departure point or lodge (Breakfast, lunch)

Hot Air Balloon Safari

Before the sun rises over the Serengeti (from any location), transfer to the balloon launch site for instruction. And as the plains are dotted with the nocturnal species returning to rest or predators on the prowl, we enjoy a one hour hot air balloon ride above them. When we return to the ground, a champagne breakfast is served and flight certificates issued – US\$599 per person
